Minutes of 5th Meeting of the Apex Level Land Allotment Committee to be held under the Chairmanship of Sh. Atal Dulloo IAS, Chief Secretary, J&K on 02nd Feb 2024.

The 5th meeting of the Apex Level Land Allotment Committee, J&K, constituted under clause (9), sub-clause (9.2, as amended) of Jammu and Kashmir Industrial Land-Allotment Policy, 2021-30, was held on 02-02-2024 in the Meeting Hall, 2nd Floor, Civil Secretariat, Jammu, under the chairmanship of Sh. Atal Dulloo IAS, Chief Secretary Jammu and Kashmir. The Agenda of the meeting and the Supplementary Note to the Agenda had been circulated earlier.

- The Member Secretary gave an overview of the last meeting and the proposed agenda of the present meeting. Thereafter detailed discussion were held and the following decisions were taken.

Agenda Item 1:

Clarifications on the points raised in 4th ALLAC Meeting held on 26-12-2023.

Member Secretary to ALLAC while elaborating on the discussion held in the last meeting, gave a detailed response to all issues thised in 4th ALLAC meeting held on 26-12-2023, forming part of the Agenda to the 5th ALLAC meeting

a) The Member Secretary confirmed that as clarified in the Agenda, the current proposal maintains the integrity of the process as laid down in the J&K Land Allotment Policy 2021-30. It was clarified that the policy does not envisage the auction method as rates are pre-defined in the Policy itself. The ALLAC has to decide the allotment of land. "after proper screening and recommendation by the Divisional Level Appraisal Committee..." in terms of GO 199-IND of 2021 dated 13.10.2021.

Giving the chronology of events at Bhagthall, it was clarified that the Single Window portal, operational from 3rd May 2021, showcased available land in various industrial estates including Bhagthall and the same is visible on the portal till date. Further the evaluation criteria, approved during the 2nd ALLAC meeting, was also publicly accessible.

Investor outreach programs regularly informed investors to apply on the Single Window portal and all applications under consideration have been received for the Bhagthali land parcel. Further immediately after the cancellation of the 4-earlier allotments on 19th Sept 2023, all applications in the portal with land requirement exceeding 200 kanals were asked on 12th October 2023 to reaffirm their interest in the allotment of land and given an opportunity to submit revised DPRs.

DLAC meetings of the applications under consideration and the recommendations to ALLAC, were done within the specified period in line with policy guidelines. The applications were appraised by the DLAC on the 15 parameters which are specified in the policy.

It was further clarified that as long as no applications are missed out from the allotment process because of lack of appraisal by DLAC, there is no infringement of the allotment process. In line with this principle, 2 applications which were received after the 4th ALLAC have also been appraised by DLAC and submitted for the consideration of the ALLAC making it a total of 22 applications under consideration.

The Committee noted the merit list of the 22 cases prepared by the I&C Deptt as per the laid down norms and approved the proposal for grant of land allotment to the following 03 cases on the basis of merit as per the details prepared by the Deptt subject to the compliance with the codal formalities and laid down norms by the allottees and subject to the condition that in line with the decision in the 3rd ALLAC, the quantum of land of all 3 cases would be reduced by DLAC proportionately to meet the availability of land without impacting the viability of the
